***Note from the Chief Adjudicators:** The WSDC debating rules describe ESL and EFL status for teams. They are silent about status for individual speaker awards. We have adapted the ESL and EFL status for the speaker tab. Essentially, an EFL speaker is one who does not speak English at home and is not taught in English at school (except for learning English itself). An ESL speaker does not speak English at school but has at least some classes (other than English itself) in English. However, there is no requirement that English not be an official language of the country, as that applies only to team status. Hence we accepted ESL status for speakers from teams such as Pakistan, even though the team was not eligible for the ESL team award.*
